

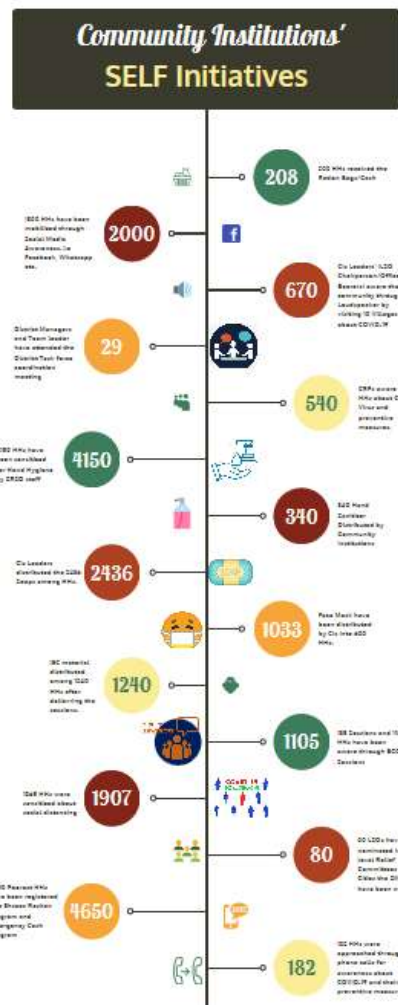

Khairpur, Umerkot, Sanghar, Badin, Thatta, Mirpurkhas, Sukkur & Ghotki

The CIs are serving the humanity on self-resources basis to mitigate the impact of the lockdown to curb the deadly covid-19 spread which in turn makes the poor people lives with no job work and livelihood. In this situation, to protect the poor, the CIs have taken an initiative of free distribution of ration bags.

Therefore, under the Peoples' Poverty Reduction Program, community Institutions on self-initiative basis has started a Ration distribution drive to provide essential items to needy families. They are driving this drive on different financial resources basis: Cos saving, Collection of Donation and Getting assistance from different philanthropists.

Moreover, CIs have also distributed sanitizers' and masks to around hundreds of families in their villages. "Most of these families rely on daily wages and are lacking access to essentials since the lockdown was announced.

CIs are appealing to philanthropist and community wellbeing people that the need of the hour is that everyone who has resources and is capable of helping the needy should come forward for this noble cause to serve the humanity.

Community institutions have already get recognition form district administration through their notification. Now, after COVID-19 emergency, District Administration has actively involved every LSO focal person in Union Council based relief committees.

In addition to this, Assistant Commissioners on direction of their concern DCs, have notified and nominated LSO representatives' in Union council Relief committees in Khairpur District, Umerkot District, Badin and Mirpurkhas.

District Managers have already submitted the list of LSO volunteers at Union Council Level.

LSO office bearers are actively working as a volunteer in relief committees and assisting them in identification of rightly needy persons who are impacted due to lockdown situation and they belong to daily wagers/mazdood occupation household.

In Khairpur DC have notified the Four Tehsils: Khairpur, FaizGanj, Naaraz and Kingri) LSOs. Same this in Mirpurkhas four tehil's LSO have also been notified and in Umer Kot also. In cities, the SRSO Unit Incharges are nominated as a focal person at Ward level.

POOREST COMMUNITY REGISTRATION IN EHSAAAS RASHAN/EMERGENCY CASH PROGRAM

For ease of access and registration to this program for community, SRSO translated the guidance steps provided by Ehsaas program into Sindhi Language. Now CIs, CRPs and SRSO staff is assisting the poorest community, having no access of mobile/internet to register themselves for Ehsaas Ration/Emergency Cash program. Moreover, they are sending the CNIC number without any dash to 8171 for registration and receiving different messages.

This program has been introduced in the context of the economic hardship being experienced by the vulnerable due to the ongoing coronavirus crisis-lockdown.

In addition, 'Ehsaas Ration Program' online registration is helpful for households' which are underprivileged or needy people to register themselves for the procurement of food-related items.

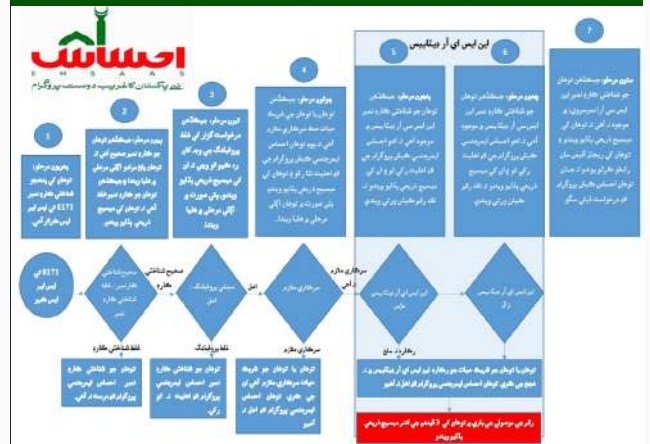
CIs, CRPs and SRSO staff are enrolling the households by filling a registration form. In the registration form, deserving people seeking food rations have to provide their basic information i.e. name, CNIC no, mobile number, number of family members, and residential address. If an applicant doesn't receive the ration within four days after he/she applied for that, he/she will require to send an SMS to 4471 mentioning his/her name, address, CNIC number and phone number or register information through online website provided by authorities'.

FACE MASK & SOAPS DISTRIBUTION

A LSO chairperson named **Koonj** said that when I walked out of home to go in the neighbors, what I saw that in street 3 children along with mother were crying for dry (Chapati) and begging in the name of Allah for charity .They were steering me as a hope and looking me like a benevolent.

When I saw this, my tears bursts from eyes and thinking that if these conditions are of every poor person who is daily wagger Laborer or employee then how wealthy people are living and sleeping with relax but its time when COVID-19 Lockdown emergency, has frozen the meal of poorest families. These children were begging and saying that **"Aunty, my father can not earn being a laborer due to lockdown from last ten days and we have neither flour nor money to eat meal.**

I came back to my home and pick up whatever I have in my home (baked food) and provided them. on that day I decided to do charity of my salary (**Working as a Polio Worker**) and when my salary deposited in my account. At first, I withdrawn my salary and later sent my husband to purchase the ration items and distributed among the **17** poorest households.

As, we have learned in social mobilization that we have to think for others for betterment of their lives and at this time we cannot leave them alone. Later, I requested to all my Vos and Cos to collect donation and distribute ration among households. In addition, we successfully collected amount and distributed ration among 50 households who were member of our CI's.

We all know that they are in want and that it is the first duty of humanity to relieve them," "To relieve the wants of our suffering humanity is an unquestionable duty.
